**Breakfast Club**: Breakfast Club runs each morning starting at 8:15am, £1.25 per session. Your child can enjoy toast, cereals, fruit and a drink. No need to book just come along to the main entrance.



**SEND:** All Darlington schools both maintained and academies have a similar approach to meeting the needs of pupils with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) and are supported by the local authority (LA) to be as inclusive as possible with children's needs being met in a mainstream school wherever possible. We are committed to working with parents and carers to identify a child's needs and provide appropriate support. Parents are provided with a leaflet explaining SEND provision and practice within our school which can be requested from main reception, however should you have further questions or concerns please arrange an appointment with our Special Educational Needs and Disability Co-ordinator, Mrs Dummett.

West Park Academy Coffee Morning: Every Friday morning 9:00am—10:00am, starting 29th September 2017, there will be a coffee morning in the Family Support Hub. Parents are welcome to call in and have a chat with Mrs Graham or Mrs Dummett and other parents. We will be having regular visits from the school nurse and other family services so if any parents want to find out information or ask questions come along. All welcome.

**School Meals:** If you would like to make a change to your child's current meal pattern: ie changing from Packed Lunch to School Meal or vice versa then please inform the school office, giving two weeks notice.

**Nut Allergy**: Just to make you aware that we do have children with nut allergies in school. Please be mindful when sending food into school.

Healthy Eating: At West Park Academy we encourage healthy eating and want lunchtime to provide a nourishing break within school, therefore can we remind parents that sweets and chocolate bars are not allowed in children's packed lunch. Such things as Mars Bars, animal chocolate, Crunchie bars and fruity sweets.

**Primary School Applications:** If your child was born between 1st September 2013 and 31st August 2014 they will be starting school in the academic year which begins September 2018. You will need to apply online via Darlington Borough Council School Admissions, telephone number is 01325 406333.

Individual School Photographs will be taken on Wednesday 11th October 2017. If your child has siblings, who do not attend West Park Academy, they may come into school from 8.30am onwards, a ticket will be given on arrival for a place in the queue. All children who attend West Park Academy will have their photographs taken throughout the school day.

**Bikes and Scooters:** Could children and parents please dismount from bicycles and scooters at the entrance gates to school. For health and safety reasons bicycles and scooters are not permitted on the playground. Could you also ensure that you stay on the paved areas and not use the grass.

**Dogs:** Please ensure all dogs are tied up at a clear distance from the school entrance - not all children are confident or happy around dogs.

**PE Kits**: Please ensure your child has their indoor and outdoor PE Kit in school each Monday for the whole week. PE days can change, therefore your child should always have a PE kit in school.



Lost Property: We are trying to reduce the amount of lost clothing in school, please help us by clearly labelling all clothing. Children are responsible for their coats etc. When an item of clothing has been found it will go into one of the lost property boxes (large red boxes) which are situated outside the school's main entrance. All unclaimed items will be disposed of at the end of the first week upon classes return, following a school holiday. Name Labels can be purchased from Elizabeth's Embroidery.

Contact Details: If you have moved address, had a change of telephone number or need to update emergency contact details we ask that you inform the school office immediately. This is to enable the school to contact you in an emergency should one occur.
