West Park Day Nursery (WPDN): Please ensure when dropping children off at WPND to walk through school main gates **not** school car park. Please do not park in the school car park for any reason. This is for health and safety reasons.

Healthy Eating: At West Park Academy we encourage healthy eating and want lunchtime to provide a nourishing break within school, therefore can we remind parents that sweets and chocolate bars are not allowed in children's packed lunches.

Nursery Admissions: If your child was born between 1st September 2015 - 31st August 2016 and you would like your child to attend West Park Academy Nursery in September 2019, then please contact the school office on 01325 380792. We offer a choice of flexible hours ie: five mornings or five afternoons or two and a half days at the start or end of the week.

Breakfast Club: Breakfast Club runs each morning for starting at 8:15am, £1.25 per session. Your child can enjoy toast, cereals, fruit and a drink. No need to book just come along to the main entrance.

Lost Property: Please check the lost property boxes (large red boxes) which are situated at the front of the school, near the main entrance. We make every attempt to reunite clothes with their owner. PE Kits: Please ensure your child has their **indoor** PE Kit/shoes and **outdoor** PE Kit/shoes in school each Monday for the whole week. PE days can change, therefore your child should always have a PE kit in school.
