Social Networking Advice for Parents

This website from the NSPCC supports you by keeping you up to date with popular social media apps. It tells you what they are and how to use them. There are excellent guides on how to report misuse and also how to ensure privacy settings are setup correctly for you and your children. Most social networking sites have a recommended age restriction of 13 but we understand that some children still do use them in primary school. Therefore it is essential that if they are using them, they are not putting themselves at risk. Please visit the website to find out more.









Lost Property: We are trying to reduce the amount of lost clothing in school. Please help us by clearly labelling all clothing, that way the item can be returned to your child. Children are responsible for their coats, jumpers etc. When an item of clothing has been found it will go into one of the lost property boxes (large red boxes) which are situated at the front of the school, near the main entrance. Please check these boxes for any lost property. Both boxes are **overflowing**, these items **must** belong to children in school, **please** look through them to find any missing items. Name Labels can be purchased from Elizabeth's Embroidery.

School Menus: We will be starting a new 3 week menu on Monday 24th April 2017. All children have made their Choices. If you feel your child does not like the choice they have made, please inform the school office and we will amend accordingly.

If you wish to make a change to your child's current meal pattern: ie changing from packed Lunch to School Meal or vice versa, then please contact the school office.

Bikes and Scooters: Could children and parents please dismount from bicycles and scooters at the entrance gates to school. For health and safety reasons bicycles and scooters are not permitted on

the playground. Could you also ensure that you stay on the paved areas and not use the grass.

Dogs: Dogs are **not** allowed on the school premises. Please ensure that all dogs are kept outside the school gates, and are tied up at a distance from the school entrance gates. Thank you.

PE Kits: Please ensure your child has their indoor PE Kit/shoes and outdoor PE Kit/shoes in school each Monday for the whole week. PE days can change, therefore your child should always have a PE kit in school.

Contact Details: If you have moved address, had a change of telephone number or need to update emergency contact details we ask that you inform the school office immediately. This is to enable the school to contact you in an emergency should one occur.

Information: Please note the school day is 8.45am -3.30pm. If you require your child to leave at any point during the school day evidence must be provided with a reason.

Also if a message is required to be passed onto your child please contact the school office by 3:00pm at the latest.
