Meal Pattern: If you would like to make a change to your child's current meal pattern: ie changing from Packed Lunch to School Meal or vice versa then please inform the school office, giving two weeks notice.

Nut Allergy: Just to make you aware that we do have children with nut allergies in school. Please be mindful when sending food into school, this includes products such as Chocolate nut spread etc.

After School Clubs: Due to safeguarding please inform the school office if your child no longer wishes to attend an after school club. It is **important** that we are notified so we know the whereabouts of all children attending.



This will also allow the place to be given to another child if needed. If your child's PE kit has been taken home after a club please ensure it is back in school the following day.

Data Protection:

Co-op: Thank you to the **Co-op** for their kind donation which allowed West Park Academy to purchase girls' football kit, netball kit, bibs and shin pads for use at matches and tournaments.

Lost Property: We are trying to reduce the amount of lost clothing in school, please help us by clearly labelling all clothing. Children are responsible for their coats etc. When an item of clothing has been found it will go into one of the lost property boxes (large red boxes) which are situated outside the school's main entrance. All unclaimed items will be disposed of at the end of the first week upon classes return, following a school holiday. Name Labels can be purchased from Elizabeth's Embroidery.

Slapped Cheek: There have been numerous cases of slapped cheek within school. If you think your child may be suffering from this could you please confirm with the doctor and inform school accordingly. Even though there is no recommended period to be kept away from school, if you are pregnant please take advice from your midwife to confirm if you are immune.

PE & PE Kits: Please ensure **no** jewellery is worn for school as it must be removed for PE, it can cause injury and can easily get lost. Please ensure your child has their indoor and outdoor (including outdoor shoes) PE Kit in school each Monday for the whole week. PE days can change, therefore your child should always have a PE Kit in school.
