## **Christmas Parties**

The children have been decorating paper party bags in school ready to bring home to fill with their food to bring back for their party. All the parties will take place in school. The dates are as follows:

- Tuesday 17th December 2019 Year 3 & 4 3:00pm until 4:00pm
- Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December 2019 Year 5 & 6 3:00pm until 4:00pm
- Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December 2019 Nursery am & pm children 8:45am until 11:45am (no afternoon nursery)
- Thursday 19th December 2019 Reception 1 & 2 12.30pm 3.30pm

On their party day, children will need to bring their decorated party bag, filled with party food just for themselves – **one savoury item** (small bun, wrap etc), **one sweet item** (biscuit, cereal bar, fruit etc) and **one treat**. As we have children in school with allergies, please avoid sending any items containing nuts. Drinks will be provided by school.

Children will be having school lunch as usual, they will have additional food during their party afternoon.

Please note that due to limited space, bags cannot be stored in a refrigerator at school.

Nursery and Reception children will attend school in their party clothes. All other year groups to bring party clothes with them on the day of their party to change into.
