
Welcome Back


We can't wait to welcome you back but things may seem a little different at first. To help we have put together a few documents to help you get familiar with the new look school. Everyone returning will receive a letter before they start with pictures explaining who they are going to be with and contact details for their teacher. Unfortunately not everyone will be with their regular teacher but we have endeavoured to ensure there is always a familiar face in the classroom.



We are operating a one way system through the school grounds and ask parents to carry out strict social distancing when dropping off and picking up children. It is essential that you stick to the correct timings for your child attending school, this is to minimise the amount of people on the school grounds at any one time.



When you arrive at the gates you will need to enter through the left gate.



8.45am Arrival – This is for children already attending as Keyworker children. The will go to the yard and line up in front of the year group signs using the chalk marks as intervals.



9:05am- Nursery – Head slightly to the left and then line up in front of the bunting (observing social distancing). Staff will be at the door ready to welcome you back.





9:25am – Reception - Head to the left and round to the yard following the one way system. At the bunting staff will welcome your children and they will head to class where another member of staff will help settle them.

9:45am– Year 1 – Head to the left and round to the yard. Parents stop at the bunting and staff will come to welcome the children and line them up (observing social distancing) before they go into school together.












10:05am – Year 6 – Parents please leave your children at the gate they will head up the one way system. Then a the paving slabs the children will go to the right and around the back of the hall. This will lead to the gate to the field. At the correct time staff will open this gate and children will go direct to classes. Whilst waiting there are multiple lines on the floor for the children to know where to socially distance.











At pick up time, please go to the place you dropped your child off at and staff will be there to greet you. Please observe strict social distancing and follow the one way systems (only the main gate will be open).

During this time it is important that the teacher focuses on getting the children into school safely and happily so we are asking parents not to engage staff in conversation.



If you need to speak to a teacher please email them directly with any information / queries and a follow up phone call can be sorted if needed.



Alternatively you can telephone the school office who can pass a message on. We are only accepting pre-booked visitors to the main office to help support with social distancing measures.

Although it all may seem a little strange at first, staff will be on hand to help and we will soon all get used to the new arrangements.
