
I also want to thank every child for all the memories, hard work and the learning that we have shared over the year.

Uniform: School uniform must be worn at all times:

- Grey trousers/skirt
- Yellow or purple polo top
- Green jumper/cardigan no hoodies allowed

PE Kits:

- Black shorts
- Purple round neck t-shirt
- Plimsoles
- Trainers
- Tracksuit/joggers for outdoor use for cold weather

To support families with the cost of buying uniform you can buy uniform from most local supermarkets. The logo is optional, this can be added by a local business if you wish, which is less expensive than buying branded uniform.

Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name on.

Snack: Children can bring in a healthy snack for morning break which should consist of fruit or a cereal bar. Please do not send in sweets or chocolate.



School Meals: We have a delicious new menu for September 2022, which is on the website, that is not only nutritious but tasty with different options available each day. The salad bar has been re-introduced and has proved to be extremely popular with the children. The daily cost of a school meal is £2:10, if you would like your child to have school meals please contact the school office on 01325 380792.

Healthy Lunch: We all want our children to feel good about themselves. A healthy lunch every day will give your child the energy and nutrients they need to grow, develop and learn. Our school dinners provide children with healthy, tasty and nutritious food but are also designed to appeal to their tastes. If you do choose to send a packed lunch, please can you ensure that there are no sweets or fizzy drinks, whilst also being mindful of children with nut allergies.

Nursery: At West Park Academy nursery we offer both 15 hour and 30 hour funded places spread across the week, Monday to Friday. This can be either morning sessions, afternoon sessions or 4 and a half days if you are entitled to 30 hours.

Our nursery is teacher led with all staff taking the time to understand individual children and consider the whole child. Our children are encouraged to explore their own interests whilst engaging in open-ended activities that will give them a love of learning which will promote curiosity to explore, investigate, discover and promote independence. Outdoor Play: We continue to play outdoors at lunch times and playtimes. Please ensure that your child has suitable outdoor clothing and footwear each day and that they **are clearly named.**



During the hot weather please can you ensure that your child has either had sun cream applied or brings a bottle with them into school. **Named** sun hats or caps are also recommended.

School Correspondence: Where possible we are now sending letters via email. Please look out for emails from West Park Academy, if you are not receiving these emails please contact the school office to update your email address or check junk/spam folder.

Contact Details: If you have moved address, had a change of telephone number or need to update emergency contact details we ask that you inform the school office immediately. This is to enable the school to contact you in an emergency should one occur.
