Joseph Pease joined his father Edward and other members of the Pease family in starting the Stockton and Darlington Railway Company. He also paid for the building of the Darlington town clock and town hall, as a gift to Darlington.

<u>George Gordon Hoskins</u> was an English architect. He was almost entirely responsible for Victorian Darlington



and In Darlington, major works include the Pease Public Library (1884), the King's Head Hotel (1890-3) and the QE college.

Trade

Darlington was a market town that was successful because of the animal trading that took place there. The railway helped to bring wealth to the town.

Beliefs

Many people in Darlington once followed a Christian group called Quakers. They would attend meetings to worship God.

Legacy

Joseph Pease, Edward Pease and George Stephenson's legacies remains today. The train station continues to be a central link to London and beyond.
