## Geography

**Map** – Tells you where things are in an area.

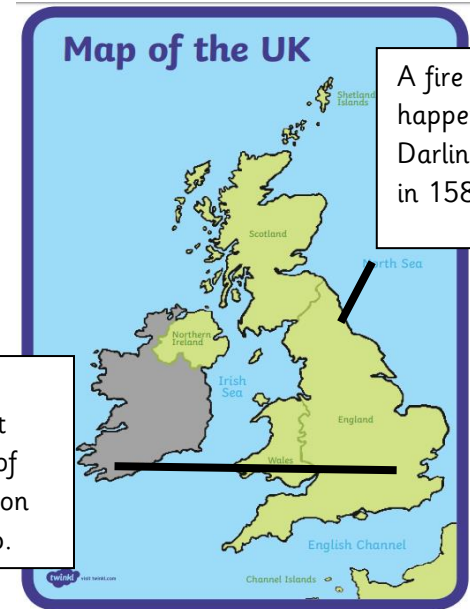
**Building** – A structure made for a purpose, e.g. shop, house etc.

**Secondary source** – Information that has been collated by someone else.

**Fieldwork** – Collecting evidence first hand based on your own observations.

## Art

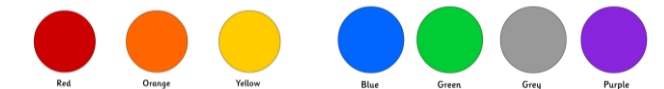
**Primary colours** – Red, yellow and blue cannot be made using other colours.

**Secondary colours** – Green, purple and orange can be made by mixing the primary colours.

**Shade** – Adding more of a darker colour or adding white can change the shade of a colour.

Warm colours

Cold colours



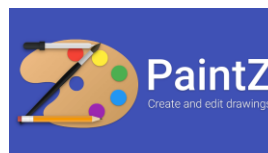
## Computing

**Brush tool** – A digital paintbrush

**Fill tool** – Flood fill an area with the same colour.

**Shape tool** – Add shapes to digital art.

**Paintz.app** – Software used to create digital artwork.



## History

**The Fire of London** happened in 1666.

**Samuel Pepys** – A man who created a diary about the fire. This was an important **source** of information.



**Artefact** – An item which gives us information about an event in the past.

**Source** – A picture, a newspaper or any form writing which tells us about an event in the past.
