**Equator**- The equator is a circle of latitude that divides Earth into the Northern and Southern hemispheres.

Magma: Molten rock BELOW the earth's surface

Lava: Molten rock ABOVE the earth's surface

**Evacuate:** Removal of someone from danger to a safe place.


Aid: Help that is given in a time of emergency.


**Disaster:** A accident or natural catastrophe that results in loss of life.

**Europe:** The second smallest continent in the world.


Italy: A country in Europe

How a fossil is formed



#### An animal dies. Some parts of the body decay and, usually, only the skeleton is left.

The skeleton is covered with sand, earth, rock or seabed before the bones can disappear.

fill the space in layers, in the exact shape of the bones.
