Children's Mental Health Week will take place from 5th - 11th February 2024. This year's theme is '**My Voice Matters**'. On Monday 5th February 2024 we would like the children to come into school dressed in colours that make them happy.



The Mental Health team will be leading assemblies and completing work in class around My Voice Matters. The children will be provided with the tools they need to express themselves.

When we feel empowered, there is a positive impact on our wellbeing. Children who feel that their voices are heard and can make a difference, have a greater sense of community and self-esteem.

Safer Internet Day Safer Internet Day will take place on **6th February 2024**, with celebrations and learning based around the theme 'Inspiring change?' In school the children will take part in an assembly and carry out some follow up activities in class.

We want children to make a difference with their actions online and navigate online changes. Websites, games, apps are constantly updating and changing, this can cause a lot of anxiety for children. Especially when all of a sudden they can't do something they found easy because of a change or update. We want to encourage the children to be resilient and know where to go for support.



Lates: The school day starts at 8:45am. Being on time is important for your child's wellbeing, achievement and wider development. Coming in late to a lesson that has already started can mean missed learning and can leave your child feeling anxious. Late marks affect the overall attendance and may result in a fine.
