**microhabitat** — A microhabitat is a small habitat that is different to the surrounding environment. This includes the area under a log.


**habitat** - A habitat is a home environment for plants and animals or other organisms. Examples of habitats include: desert; meadow; woodland; grassland and forest

food chain




Life Cycle of a Frog
