Loombands

POKEMON CARDS

You are allowed to bring Pokémon cards into school but you must follow these rules.

- No swapping in class
- No arguing over who the cards belong to.
- Only swap cards if you do not want it back. You can not ask once you have swapped.
- Do not tell a child they are real if they are not.
- Put the cards away during class and when asked when any member of staff including the lunch time supervisors.
- Do not go in other people's tray or bags.

Playing on the field



On the field you can enjoy the following:

Play football, every year group will get a time to play football. You will have one goal each for each Year group. You may have to wait your turn to play.

Play with the equipment with the play leaders! Don't steal off other people when they are playing with the equipment you can ask to play with them or ask after their have gone inside. You can have a good lunch break if you don't steal .

Do gymnastics safely. When you do this make sure there is no one around you so you don't hurt others or get hurt yourself. Stay away from the football area. Also you could do gymnastics in a small group. This can be fun but stay safe by not doing things that are dangerous or out of your comfort zone. If you are throwing each other in the air please make sure that there is at least 5 people around you so you don't get hurt.





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Wilderness



Children can play anywhere they want to when they are in the wilderness.

You can make dens, run around, play hide and seek and climb trees. Make sure you do not go too high when climbing- Do not climb higher than your shoulder.

You can move the sticks but they should be kept upright when carrying them about so you don't knock them into anyone.

When making dens please try to share and do not steal off each other.
