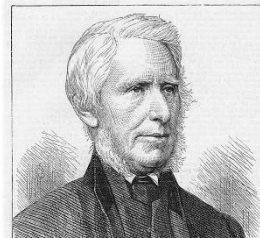

What is important to 'Our Darling Town'?



Vocabulary	
architecture	Designing and constructing buildings
human feature	Things that are made or built by humans
industry	A group of businesses that make or sell products or perform services.

location	The place where a particular point or object exists.

Quakers	A group of people who believed that everyone could talk to God directly, without a priest.



George Gordon Hoskins was an English architect. He was almost entirely responsible for Victorian Darlington and in Darlington, major works include the Pease Public Library (1884), the King's Head Hotel (1890-3) and the QE college.



Joseph Pease joined his father Edward and other members of the Pease family in starting the Stockton and Darlington Railway Company. He also paid for the building of the Darlington town clock and town hall, as a gift to Darlington.
